ROTARY NEW YEAR WITH CHILDREN | JULY 1, 2025 BENEFICIARY: LAMOSIG ELEMENTARY SCHOOL AS THE ROTARY NEW YEAR BEGAN ON JULY 1, 2025, THE ROTARACT CLUB OF BUTUAN NORTH HIRAYA WELCOMED THE NEW CHAPTER NOT WITH GRAND CELEBRATIONS, BUT WITH SOMETHING MORE MEANINGFUL; TIME, CARE, AND SERVICE FOR THE CHILDREN OF LAMOSIG ELEMENTARY SCHOOL.

THROUGH "TURNING PAGES, TRANSFORMING LIVES: A ROTARACT PABASA INITIATIVE," ROTARACTORS SPENT THE DAY ALONGSIDE YOUNG LEARNERS, HELPING THEM READ, WORK THROUGH THEIR LEARNING ACTIVITIES, AND DISCOVER THE JOY THAT COMES FROM HAVING SOMEONE PATIENTLY GUIDE AND ENCOURAGE THEM. IN EVERY SHARED PAGE AND EVERY WORD READ TOGETHER WAS A SIMPLE MESSAGE: YOUR LEARNING MATTERS, AND YOU ARE NOT ALONE IN YOUR JOURNEY.

THE ACTIVITY ALSO PROVIDED THE CHILDREN WITH SCHOOL SUPPLIES TO HELP THEM PREPARE FOR ANOTHER YEAR OF LEARNING. WHILE THESE MATERIALS MAY SEEM SIMPLE, THEY CAN MAKE A MEANINGFUL DIFFERENCE TO A CHILD WHO NEEDS THE BASIC TOOLS TO PARTICIPATE CONFIDENTLY IN THE CLASSROOM. MORE THAN GIVING SUPPLIES, THE PROJECT SOUGHT TO ENCOURAGE THE LEARNERS TO KEEP SHOWING UP, KEEP LEARNING, AND KEEP BELIEVING IN WHAT THEY CAN ACHIEVE.

ADDING WARMTH AND EXCITEMENT TO THE GATHERING WAS A FEEDING PROGRAM FEATURING THE CHILDREN'S FAVORITE JOLLIBEE SPAGHETTI AND CHICKEN. LAUGHTER, CONVERSATIONS, AND EAGER SMILES FILLED THE SCHOOL AS THE CHILDREN ENJOYED THEIR MEAL AND THE COMPANY OF THE ROTARACT VOLUNTEERS. FOR A WHILE, THE CLASSROOM BECAME MORE THAN A PLACE FOR LESSONS, IT BECAME A SPACE FOR CONNECTION, CELEBRATION, AND SHARED HAPPINESS.

THE ROTARACTORS ALSO TOOK TIME TO SIT PERSONALLY WITH THE LEARNERS. SOME GUIDED CHILDREN THROUGH THEIR READING EXERCISES, WHILE OTHERS ASSISTED THEM WITH THEIR WORKSHEETS AND ACTIVITIES. THESE MOMENTS REFLECTED THE HEART OF THE PROJECT: SERVICE IS NOT ALWAYS ABOUT GIVING SOMETHING TANGIBLE. SOMETIMES, IT IS ABOUT GIVING YOUR TIME, YOUR ATTENTION, AND THE ASSURANCE THAT SOMEONE BELIEVES IN YOU.

THE CELEBRATION WAS MADE EVEN MORE MEANINGFUL BY THE PRESENCE OF THE ROTARY FAMILY AND THE RECOGNITION GIVEN TO THOSE WHO CONTRIBUTED TO THE INITIATIVE. CERTIFICATES OF APPRECIATION WERE PRESENTED IN GRATITUDE FOR THE INDIVIDUALS AND ORGANIZATIONS WHOSE SUPPORT HELPED MAKE THE ACTIVITY POSSIBLE.

PRESIDED OVER BY PRESIDENT REX N. BAYOTAS, THE GATHERING SUCCESSFULLY BLENDED THE SPIRIT OF ROTARY FELLOWSHIP WITH TARGETED STRATEGIC PLANNING FOCUSED ON UPLIFTING THE SURROUNDING COMMUNITY.



THE CORE AGENDA OF THE EVENING CENTERED ON EMPOWERING LOCAL YOUTH AND EXPANDING RCBN'S FOOTPRINT ACROSS EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS. HIGHLIGHTING THE AGENDA WERE AMBITIOUS PLANS TO DEEPEN PARTNERSHIPS WITH STUDENT LEADERS AND ORGANIZATIONS AT CARAGA STATE UNIVERSITY (CSU). 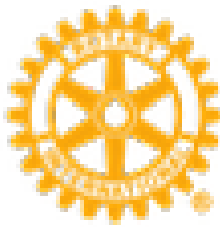
